Flavor Description

Hell Yes Ma'am is fruity, spicy, pleasantly warming, and dangerously drinkable. This beer is bursting with hints of pears, oranges, bubblegum, & pepper. Mid-palate you'll find a delicate grainy sweetness that finishes clean & spicy, warming you up as it goes down.

Story Behind the Name

Our owner Kristie Nystedt loves her Belgian beer and made a request for a strong one. She is very enthusiastic & positive so we thought it fitting to name the popular Southern phrase "Hell Yes!" after her. Fun Fact: Kristie is also the first female in North Carolina to own a brewery.

History of Style

Belgian Golden Strongs were brought into the beer-drinking public by Brewery Moortgat in Belgium (Duvel) after World War II in response to the growing popularity of the Pilsner beers of the time. Many examples carry references to the Devil or other related monastic icons.
